
As life becomes more complicated and time with family and friends becomes scarce, it's time to regroup and focus on creating quality experiences.

LAC DU BONNET TOWN DOCK & BEACH FUN FOR THE WHOLE FAMILY

The Lac du Bonnet Town Dock and Beach is located on Park Street, just a short walk from our shopping district.

While small, there is no shortage of fun! Enjoy your afternoon swimming, building sandcastles, laying in the sun with a good book, or playing with the kids on one of the play structures.

Enjoy the best of both worlds with ample shallow, calm water for your little ones to splash around while more experienced swimmers take in the deep end and enjoy an afternoon of diving off the dock, or jumping from the floating platform. With your safety in mind, lifeguards are on duty daily.

If swimming isn't your cup of tea, the dock is an excellent place for shore-side fishing in Lac du Bonnet. You'll need to grab a spot at the end of the dock and get your line ready to reel in Northers, Small Mouth Bass, or Walleye.
